NO FLY LIST

Another case involved a Muslim couple stranded in Yemen due to being placed on the no-fly list by the FBI. CAIR publicly protested this "forced exile" of Muslim Americans, whereby they leave overseas for a trip and are placed on the no-fly list after they are overseas, preventing them from returning home. CAIR-PA was successful and the couple has safely returned to Pennsylvania.

This past quarter, the CAIR-PA Civil Rights
Department received and processed many
challenging cases of discrimination. The
summer started with a case from Delaware
that received media attention.

A 16-year-old Muslim girl was harassed and intimidated by DMV employees because she wanted to get her driver's license picture taken with hijab. She was refused and ended up leaving in tears. CAIR-PA got involved and in a matter of days, the DMV Director publicly apologized, allowed the Muslim teen to get a new picture free of charge and has promised to institute new employee sensitivity training with the help of the American Civil Liberties Union of Delaware.

ISLAMOPHOBIA ADVISORY

American Muslims are facing an environment of rising anti-Muslim sentiment throughout the country, which has never been seen before, even immediately after 9/11. Economic anxiety and a new crop of anti-Muslim organizations devoted to marginalizing Muslims have spearheaded virulent mosque opposition nationwide. Numerous politicians hold all Muslims suspicious and the religion of Islam is being viewed as a threat.

All Muslims must increase their outreach efforts. Individuals should inform their neighbors about Muslim practices, and mosques are encouraged to host open houses to build relationships with its community, local government officials and law enforcement. These efforts should be taken very seriously, and the month of Ramadan is an excellent time to open your doors. Contact CAIR-PA to schedule either a "Know Your Rights" or "The Growing Problem of Islamophobia" seminar and we can help your community address these concerns.

CAIR-PA will also send a community action kit to leaders within the upcoming days on how to deal with challenges of the possibility of Eid falling on September 11th.
