**Defining Terrorism:
USA PATRIOT Act**

- [An] act of terrorism means any activity that
- (A) involves a violent act or an act dangerous to human life that is a violation of the criminal laws of the United States or any State, and would be a criminal violation if committed within the jurisdiction of the United States;
- (B) (i) is intended to intimidate or coerce a civilian population;
- (ii) is intended to influence the policy of a government by assassination or kidnapping.

"what sets terrorist acts apart are the political motivations of their perpetrators"




Muslim People Today

Nature of the Conflict: Actions

Before Hadi bin Mubarak Qahtani exploded himself into an anonymous fireball, he was young and interested only in "fooling around." Like many Saudis, he was said to have experienced a **religious awakening** after the Sept. 11, 2001, attacks on the United States and dedicated himself to Allah, inspired by "the holy attack that demolished the foolish infidel Americans and caused many young men to awaken from their deep sleep."

On April 11, he died as a suicide bomber, part of a coordinated insurgent attack on a U.S. Marine base in the south of Baghdad. Just before the attack, he had found in Iraq an accessible way to die

- A religious juridical verdict, legal opinion
- Authority for: Qur'an and Sunnah.
- Issued by: *mufti*, (Islamic Judges)
- Importance:
It gives religious sanction to war



**Clarifying Critique:
The Enemy: "Al-Qaeda"**

- Global jihadist network vs. monolithic entity.
- Three distinct entities.
 1. Core vanguard, (Al-Qaeda prime) → Osama bin Laden and his trusted associates.
 2. Al-Qaeda franchise groups such as Al-Qaeda in Iraq,
 3. Grassroots jihadist movement inspired by Al-Qaeda prime and the franchise groups

Al-Qaeda Prime

- Under intense pressure by the U.S. government and its allies,
- Reduced in size since 9/11
- Remains relatively small because of operational security concerns.
- Laying low in Pakistan near the Afghan border and comprises only a small portion of the larger jihadist universe.

Al-Qaeda Franchise Groups

- Local or regional terrorist or insurgent groups that have adopted jihadist ideology.
 - Some adopt PUBLICLY:
 - al-Qaeda in the Islamic Maghreb (AQIM) or
 - al Qaeda in the Arabian Peninsula (AQAP).
 - Other groups PRIVATELY adopt some or all of al Qaeda's jihadist ideology and cooperate with the core group,
 - Maintain their independence for a variety of reasons.
 - E.g. Tehrik-i-Taliban Pakistan (TTP), Laskar-e-Taiba (LeT) and Harkat-ul-Jihad e-Islami (HUJI)

Grassroots Jihadist Movement

- People Worldwide
